Dear Parents and Caregivers

We are living in interesting times aren't we? But here at school we are all (staff, students and parents) adjusting to the new normal life at school. Thank you all for the support you have given by following the drop-off and pick-up gates routines. It certainly makes for a smoother start to school for teachers as they can meet their students in class and give them the morning attention they require. It is wonderful to see the independence the 'Kiss and wave" scheme has given to children as they take responsibility to walk into school alone or with their friends. At the end of the day, the independent senior walkers leaving at 2:55 enables us to clear the gates in readiness for the younger children leaving. Well done to you all, and thank you for helping us maintain a safe school for everyone.

A few reminders as we are getting more students back as of today:

- School gates open at 8:30am for student entry to school. No access prior to this time.
- School gates open for children at 3:00pm please collect your child promptly.
- Parents meet children outside the gates that they have said they will wait at.
- Any one parent requiring access to the school site MUST sign in at the office and hand sanitize.
- Remember to send with your child a named drinks bottle as the water fountains are not in use.

If your child forgets to bring something to school - you need to go to the office via Wykeham Place, hand sanitize, sign in and the forgotten item will be delivered to the classroom. Please DO NOT go to the classroom.

Walk into Wykeham

What a change in a week! In the first week of Level 2 it was wonderful to see children walking into Wykeham Place, and the knock-on effect of less cars entering. This week as we (the staff) have been on gate duties, we have certainly been aware of the increase in the number of cars.

Please, DO NOT park in our neighbor's driveways or across their driveway while your child exits or enters your car on pick up/drop off. There is always more parking if you park in Lingfield Street or Marlborough Park and walk into school by the nearest gate. We rely on the goodwill of our neighbours at pick-up and drop-off times. We do not want to abuse the support they provide by being inconsiderate with parking.
