From the Principal's Pen Dear Parents and Caregivers

Welcome to Term 4 and a huge welcome to all our new families and students. We have 9 weeks to put everything together that we wish to achieve. The teachers will continue to be on gate duty for before and after school, providing reassurance and support for those students and families who need it.

We are at COVID-19 Alert Level 1

Therefore, there are no restrictions on personal movement at this level, and all of our students should be at school from 8:30am onwards and collected at 3:00pm.

The only people who need to stay away from our school are those who:

- are required to self-isolate
- have been asked by the Health Authorities to stay away while waiting for a test result (most people will be able to go back to school/work while waiting for a result)
- children, students and staff who are unwell

Any visitors to the school site must check in using NZ Covid Tracer App which is located on the main door at Reception, or on classroom doors. At Alert Level 1, there are no restriction's on numbers at gatherings, but please continue to use hand hygiene measures - wash them, wash them, and wash them again. Please remind your child about safe cough and sneeze etiquette. Entry to classrooms requires students to hand sanitise.

- Students who are late into school must obtain a yellow 'late card' from the Office and sign in the 'Late' book.
