For the kids, there will be supervised movie screenings in the classrooms to allow the adults some time to mingle.

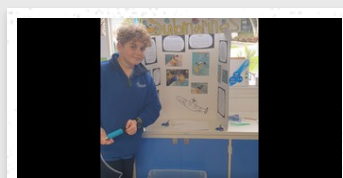
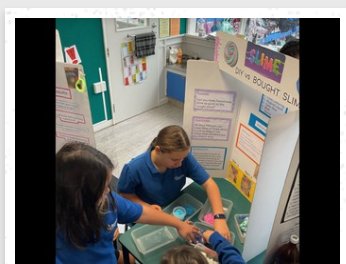

COVID-19 RE-INFECTION ADVICE

Updated advice on COVID-19 reinfections

You may have seen that the Ministry of Education has updated its advice on COVID-19 reinfections in response to the public health advice the Government shared after this week's Cabinet meeting. You can find updated Ministry advice at this [link](#).

Below are some of the basic points in the Ministry advice:

If a person tests positive for COVID-19 again 29 days (or later) after a previous COVID-19 infection, the person is required to self-isolate again for seven days. This timeframe has decreased from the previous timeframe of 90 days.

Out of Zone applications for 2023 will close on 14th November - Ballot will be held on Friday

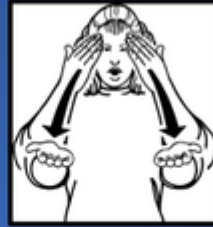
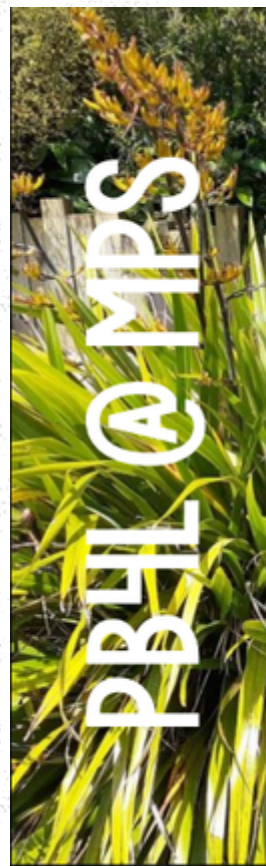
