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Marlborough Primary School Enrolment Zone and Deadlines for Applications

The school has an enrolment zone, which governs admission to the school. If you live within the zone boundary your child has a right to attend Marlborough Primary School. If you are a resident outside the zone, then an application will need to be made under the balloting provisions as covered by the Education Amendment Act. Enrolment at Marlborough Primary School is governed by an enrolment scheme.

All students who live within the home zone described below and/or shown on the attached map shall be entitled to enrol at the school.

The enrolment zone is:

Starting at the intersection of Glenfield Road and Downing Street, travel east along Downing Street (odd addresses only included) to Bentley Avenue. Travel east along Bentley Avenue (odd addresses 47 and below included) to Chartwell Avenue. Travel north along Chartwell Avenue (even addresses included, odd addresses 62 and below only included) to Chivalry Road. Travel southeast along Chivalry Road (odd addresses 107 and above only included) to Archers Road. Travel southwest along Archers Road (even addresses 168 and below only included and odd addresses 109 and below only included) to Velma Road. Travel southeast along Velma Road (both sides included, Anne Road excluded) to Coronation Road. Travel west along Coronation Road (even addresses 170 and below only included) to Glenfield Road. Travel northwest along Glenfield Road (odd addresses 275 – 381 only included), High Road included) back to the starting point.

All residential addresses on included sides of boundary roads and all no exit roads off included sides of boundary roads are included in the zone unless otherwise stated.

Proof of residence within the home zone is required by supplying two separate forms of documentation eg lease agreement, purchase agreement, telephone account or rates account upon enrolment.

Original approved by Ministry of Education 12 October, 2020 commencing from May 3rd, 2021.

Every year there will be 4 enrolment periods, and an intake of 45 spaces for the year, across all year levels.

Details relating to enrolment period for Term 1 2026 are as follows:

Enrolment period: 3 February to 2 April 2026

Deadline for receipt of application Monday 17 November 2025 at 3:00pm

Date of Ballot (if required) Friday 21 November 2025 at 9:30am

Details relating to enrolment period for Term 2 2026 are as follows:

Enrolment period: 20 April to 03 July 2026

Deadline for receipt of application: Monday 09 March 2026 at 3:00pm

Date of Ballot (if required) Friday 13 March 2026 at 9:30am

Details relating to enrolment period for Term 3 2026 are as follows:

Enrolment period: 20 July to 25 September 2026

Deadline for receipt of application: Monday 08 June at 3:00pm

Date of Ballot (if required) Friday 12 June at 9:30am

Details relating to enrolment period for Term 4 2026 are as follows:

Enrolment period: 12 October to 18 December 2026

Deadline for receipt of application: Monday 31 August at 3:00pm

Date of Ballot (if required) Friday 04 September at 9:30am

Enrolment of Out of Zone students

The Board of Trustees will consider applications if they have identified vacancies and the applicants meet the criteria of priorities 1 to 6 as per below:

First Priority This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school

does not run a special programme approved by the secretary.

Second Priority will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.

Third priority will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.

Fourth priority will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the

school.

Fifth priority will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the

board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school

Sixth priority will be given to all other applicants
